## **Jeff Landon, MSW**

Jeff Landon is the Director of the Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Programs (SOTAP). SOTAP provides prison based sexual deviancy treatment for nearly 600 clients annually. SOTAP also provides community based treatment to approximately 500 offenders annually, upon release from incarceration. Mr. Landon is a certified Static 99, Stable and Acute 2007 trainer, having trained with Andrew J.R. Harris Ph.D. He is a clinical member of the Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers (ATSA), serves on the board of directors for the Washington State chapter of ATSA, and serves as Washington State DOC's expert in sex offender treatment, assessment, management, and policy.

## **Renee Schuiteman, MSW**

Renee Schuiteman is the Program Manager of the Airway Heights Correction Center (AHCC) Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Programs (SOTAP). AHCC SOTAP provides prison based treatment to approximately 175 offenders. Treatment includes adjunct groups, community transition classes, and a denier program facilitated by the psychologist at AHCC SOTAP. Ms. Schuiteman is a certified Static 99, Stable and Acute 2007 trainer, having trained with Andrew J.R. Harris Ph.D. She also serves on the Sexually Aggressive Youth and Physically Aggressive Youth committee with the Washington State Department of Health and Human Services.

## **Rob Colley**

Rob Colley is a Corrections Specialist with the Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP). He specializes in the completion of Static 99 Risk Assessments for offenders who will potentially seek treatment while incarcerated with DOC. His primary focus is the offenders who are currently going through the intake process at Washington Corrections Center. Rob is a certified Static 99 trainer, having trained with Andrew J.R. Harris Ph.D. To date, Mr. Colley has completed more than 700 Static 99 assessments.
